Lavia Plus, Finca Paso Malo, 2013
DO Bierzo

Type of Wine: Red Wine
Appellation of Origin: DO Bullas
Winery: Bodegas Lavia, Bullas
Varietal: 100% Monastrell from the single vineyard, Paso Malo. The vines are 50 years old.
Terrain: Very shallow limestone soil with pebbles and alluvium with a small portion of silt. 800 meters above sea level.
Harvest: September. Hand-picked in 15 kg boxes. Sorted in the vineyard and on a sorting table before entering the winery. Partially destemmed and pressed. Gravity-fed tank filling.
Ageing: Fermentation with its own indigenous yeast in 500 litre open French oak wood barrels, with cap immersion or pigeage. Macerated for 20 days and malolactic fermentation in the same barrel.
Bottling: Bottled on the property.
Serving Temperature: Between 41° and 55° F
Alcohol Content: 15%

About the producer: In 2004, Bodegas Lavia began with a small sized winery, but equipped from the start with the latest technology. This winery was designed to fully respect the beautiful nature that surrounds it. Its facilities include tanks made of stainless steel and French oak, capable of handling a maximum of between 5,000 and 10,000 kg. The production is done in a natural and traditional manner, preserving the maximum expression and concentration of the grapes, achieving complex and distinguishable wines.

Tasting Notes: Intense, deep cherry colour. It needs time to unveil all its aromatic nuances. In the initial attack on the palate it shows its mineral character, with aeration it evolves into nuances of wild rosemary, and then ends with hints of tobacco and cigar box. Fresh and powerful mouthfeel with great structure, fullbodied but not aggressive. A lingering and persistent finish followed by mineral and earthy sensations.
