

## **Tilenus Roble, 2015** DO Bierzo

**Type of Wine:** Red Wine  
**Appellation of Origin:** DO Bierzo  
**Winery:** Bodegas Estefanía  
**Varietal:** 100% Mencia. Vines are between 40 and 60 years old.  
**Terrain:** Calcareous clay. 600-700 meters above sea level.  
**Harvest:** September.  
**Ageing:** Spontaneous. Stainless steel tanks, followed by 12 to 14 months in French oak.  
**Bottling:** Bottled on the property.  
**Serving Temperature:** Between 61° and 65° F  
**Alcohol Content:** 13%

**About the producer:** Bodegas Estefanía is a very special winery that was established in 1999 when the FRIAS family decided to restore an old creamery located in the village of Dehesas, in Ponferrada (León). Since 2014, it is part of the MG Wines Group. The name of its main Brand, Tilenus, was taken from the primitive god "Teleno", the Celtic god of war and equivalent to the Roman god, Mars. The reason for naming the wine "Tilenus" is to pay tribute to the golden years of the Roman era in the Bierzo. This era is represented on the wine labels by an etched roman coin, that was found in one of the vineyards. All this has led to a winery that produces exclusive wines in a traditional way, very carefully selecting each grape.

**Tasting Notes:** Intense, ruby red coloured wine with purple hues. We discover a bouquet of abundant red fruits (raspberry, strawberry...), fresh mouthfeel and very fine tannins which confer elegance and personality to this wine.

**Format:** 750ml (case of 12 bottles)
